Age Groups -- Game Time, Ball Size, Number of Players on Field:

- 5th/6th Grade: Two 30 Minute Halves; Size 4 Ball; 9v9 (Includes Goalie); 5 players minimum
- 7th/8th Grade: Two 35 Minute Halves; Size 5 Ball; 11v11 (Includes Goalie); 7 players minimum
- High School: Two 40 Minute Halves; Size 5 Ball; 11v11 (Includes Goalie); 7 players minimum
- All Grade Levels: 10 Minute Halftime Interval
- If team cannot start game with minimum # of players, the team must forfeit the game.

Tie Games

- Regular season games may end in a tie (no overtime).
- Playoffs: Two 5-minute Golden Goal overtime periods (first goal wins), then Penalty Kick Shoot Out, based on FIFA Laws of Game.

Intentional Heading or Directing of Ball with Head:

- 5th/6th Grade: Not Allowed. Violation results in Indirect Free Kick.
- 7th/8th Grade + High School: Is Allowed.

Playing Time, MISA Substitution Rule, Yellow/Red Cards:

- All players must participate in at least 50% of the game, unless injured. Violation can result in forfeit.
- Substitutions may occur at any stoppage of play and at the discretion of the referee.
- Player given a red card, or 2 yellow cards resulting in a red card, is ejected from game and suspended for team's next game.

Blow Out Policy:

A blowout is winning by more than 6. (7-1 is acceptable, 8-1 is not.) MISA shall enforce its blowout policy rule (see MISA website).

MISA Roster Card Policy:

- All teams must present the completed, signed, and laminated roster card at all games.
- All rosters become frozen October 1st, 2020. Exceptions can be presented to the board for approval.
- Only players and coaches listed on the roster card can participate in the respective game.
- If a team does not have the roster card prior to kickoff, the game will be played, with both coaches notifying the MISA administrator of the issue following the game. The team without a roster card will forfeit the played game, losing 3-0.
- A MISA Alliance Club, at their discretion, may approve a temporary or fill-in coach on a per game basis. The respective club's registrar must prepare a written note stating that the coach is authorized, and can be presented in an email form at check in.



The club's registrar is required to sign this roster to verify that the players and coaches listed are registered, insured with US Club Soccer, and authorized to play in the correct age group. Each club accepts all liability for players and coaches participating in the Marin Interleague Soccer Alliance.
